


Fantasy Tales



Science

Animals including Humans.

In this unit we will learn all about animal offspring. We will look at patterns within groups of fish, mammals, reptiles and amphibians. This will lead on to the life cycles and the process of change between young and adult forms of an animal. We will learn about the human life cycle and how human growth can be separated into stages. We will explore survival and what animals need to survive and finally we will look into exercise and healthy living.



Have you ever wondered if the Big Bad Wolf was really bad? During this topic we will be exploring different sides to many of the traditional tales we know and love. We will dive deeper into the characters to see what they are really like.

History - This term we will focus on changes within living memory. Looking at the lives of our grandparents and great grandparents. Looking at how their lives were different to our lives today, including toys, clothes and schooling.

Geography - Children will learn the countries of the UK including their capital cities. We will learn about cities and towns within each country and use our knowledge of north, east, south and west to talk about location.
