# READINESS FOR NURSERY 1

- It is important to spend time with them and have fun together. In the preschool years, read to them, share stories, sing songs or nursery rhymes and talk about anything and everything!
- Try to be relaxed and positive when talking about starting Nursery this encourages children to be confident, curious and ready to explore and learn.
- Rehearse separating from their parent for short amounts of time, extending this to a few hours at a time .
- Take part in the induction events.



# READINESS FOR NURSERY 2

- Encourage your child to express their needs and emotions.
- Complete a task, like a jigsaw or block construction, by themselves without direct support from an adult, working towards completing a 5-minute activity independently.
- Playing games that involve taking turns.
- Use your child's favourite toys to role-play going to nursery.
- Let your child hold the book and turn the pages as you read the story.
- Try to encourage self-care skills like readiness for toilet training, washing hands, drink from a cup, eating snacks.
- Practise the school morning routine, including getting dressed and eating breakfast in time to leave.
- With items of uniform and coats, please practice together by dressing/undressing , doing any fastenings with uniform, coats, shoes.
