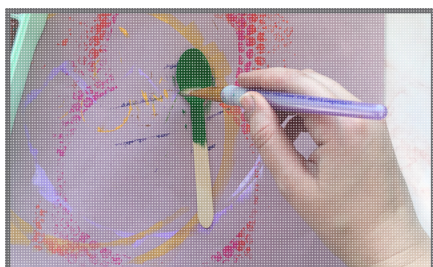


Wooden Spoon Dragon Craft

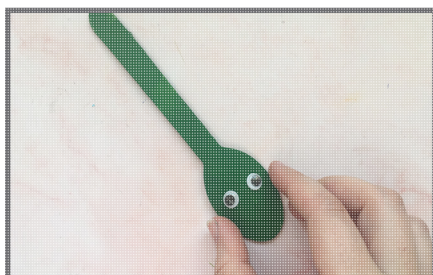


You will need:

- A wooden spoon
- Green paint or felt tip pens
- Colourful card or paper
- Glue
- Scissors
- Colourful card
- (Optional) Googly eyes



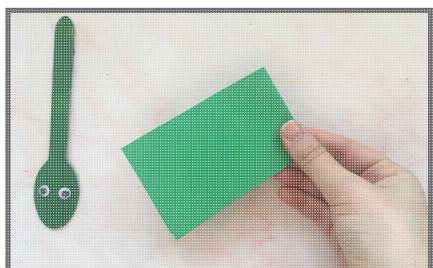
1) First, paint your wooden spoon green. Remember to cover both sides of your wooden spoon. We are using green, but you could choose a different colour for your wooden spoon dragon. Leave to dry.



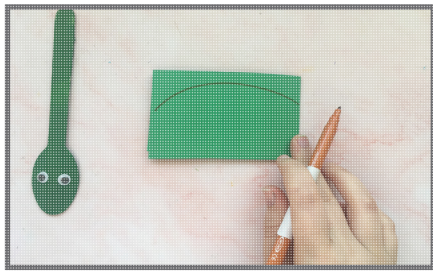
2) Once dried, turn your wooden spoon so the curved part of the spoon faces upwards like a small hill. You can then add your dragon's eyes about halfway down the length of the curved part of the spoon. We have used googly eyes, but you could cut out small circles of paper for your dragon's eyes.



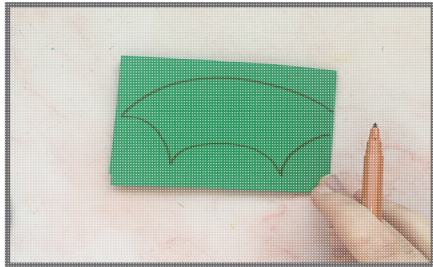
3) Now get a long strip of colourful paper or card ready to make your dragon's wings.



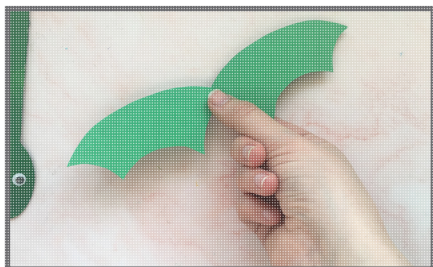
4) Bring the two shortest sides of the rectangle together to fold the paper or card in half lengthways.



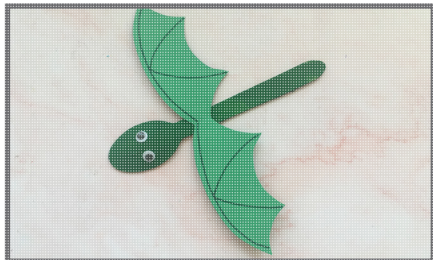
5) Draw a shallow curve along the top of the folded paper.



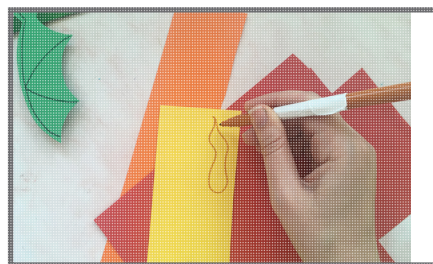
6) Then complete the bottom of the dragon wing with three bumps leading back to the folded edge of the paper. At the folded edge of the paper, leave a small connecting point. Cut around this shape through both layers of paper. Do **not** cut along the fold line.



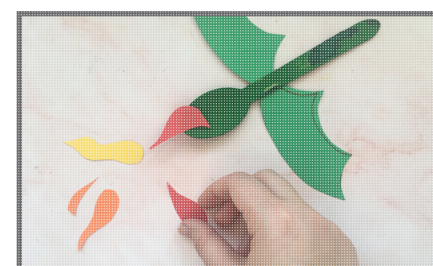
7) Unfold the paper to see your dragon's wings. You can then add extra decorations using felt tip pens.



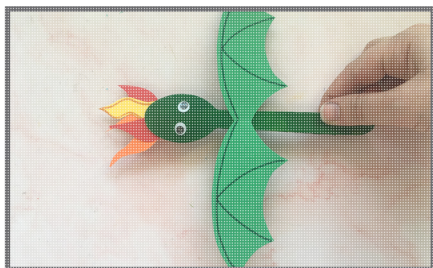
8) Then place a dab of glue on the stick of your wooden spoon, close to the curved part of the spoon. Place the centre point of your set of wings into this glue and leave to dry.



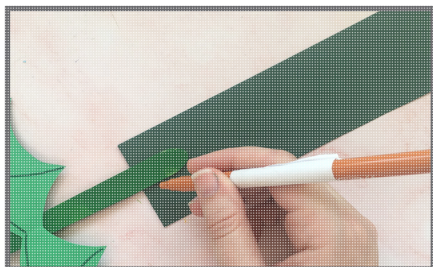
9) Next get some orange, yellow and red snips of card or paper. Cut out triangles or flame shapes from these colourful materials. You could also use tissue paper.



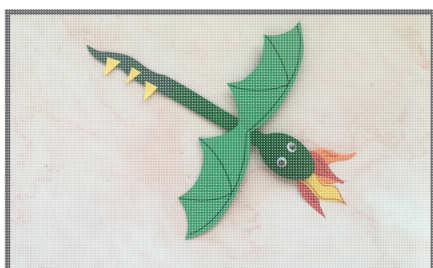
10) The turn your dragon over and glue these snips of paper to the tip of the spoon.



11) You have a fire-breathing dragon!



12) Place the end of your wooden spoon onto some green card or paper. Use this to draw a long tail shape onto the green material. Cut out the tail and then add extra decorations such as spikes to create a fierce tail for your dragon.



13) Glue the tail to the end of the wooden spoon to complete your wooden spoon dragon craft.
