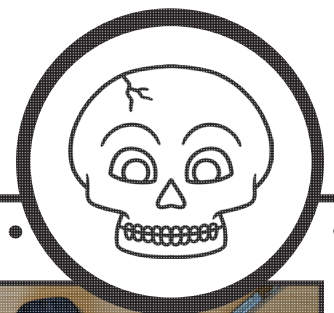
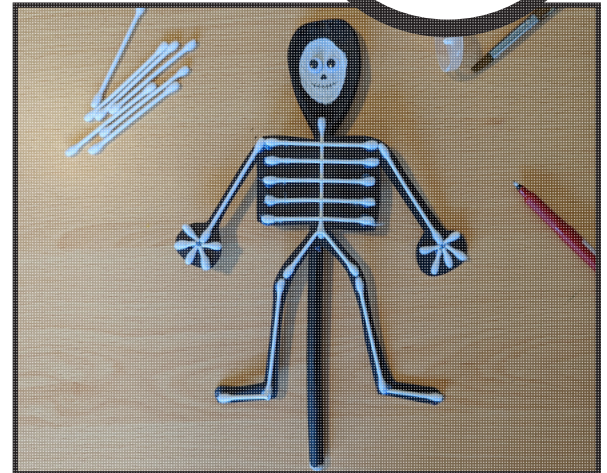


Wooden Spoon Skeleton Craft

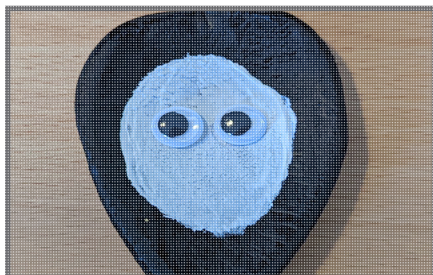


You will need:

- Wooden spoon
- Black and white paint
- Two googly eyes
- White glue
- Black card
- Cotton buds
- Scissors
- Black pen



1) First, coat the wooden spoon in the black paint. Allow the paint to dry.



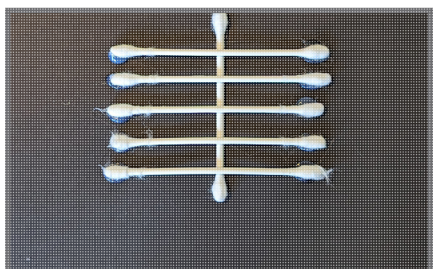
2) Next, in the middle of the spoon, paint a white egg shape for the skeleton's skull.

Use the glue to secure the two googly eyes in position on the skull.

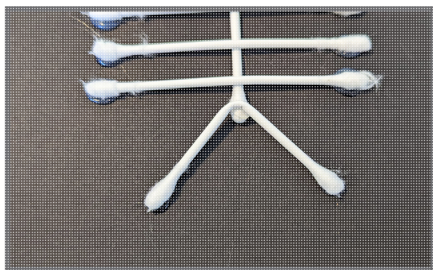
Allow the glue and the paint to dry.



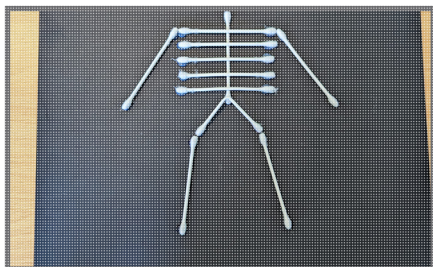
3) Draw a nose and a mouth onto the skull using the black pen.



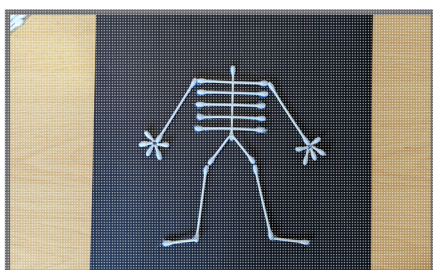
4) To create the rib cage of your skeleton, glue one cotton bud vertically underneath the skull before placing five cotton buds horizontally across. Secure them in place with the glue.



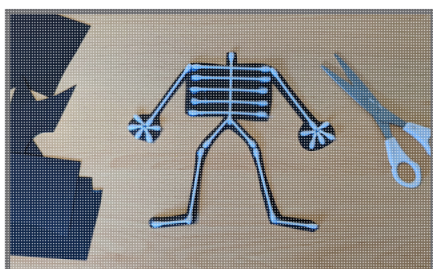
5) Fold a cotton bud in half so that it creates a v-shape. Glue this at the bottom of the rib cage so that the middle of the cotton bud points upwards. This will create the hip bones of the skeleton.



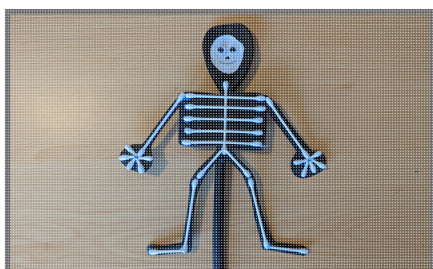
6) Glue a cotton bud on either side of the rib cage for each arm, and one at the bottom of each side of the hip bone for the legs.



7) Using scissors, cut the ends off five cotton buds to create ten individual buds. Glue five buds at the end of each arm to make the fingers. Cut a cotton bud in half and glue each half to the bottom of each leg to create the feet. Allow the glue to dry.



8) Use the scissors to cut around the outline of your cotton bud skeleton.



9) Glue the skeleton onto the wooden spoon so that the body is underneath the skull. Allow the glue to dry.
